# Measurement and offsetting of the carbon footprint.

- Carbon Footprint Calculation.
- Offsetting solutions through reforestation of degraded and desertification-prone areas.
- Management of CALCULO and COMPENSO Seals from MITECO.



### Digitalization

- We use satellite technology to measure the CO2 absorption of each tree in real time.
- We track the impact on water resources, rural employment generated, and other ESG indicators.
- We develop tools to communicate and engage Stakeholders through a customizable web platform.
- We offer gamification tools to reach end customers.



### Awareness Raising

- Coordination of reforestation, watering, and replanting volunteer activities.

history, and geographical impact



# O1 Re-Plant Days

### Conditions

- The event will be held alongside other companies on the third Friday of each month.
- The maximum number of participants per day is 90 people.
- An increase in capacity may be considered upon request (up to a maximum of 300 people).
- A minimum of 200 trees must be planted.



### Additional information.

- We plant native species adapted to the local ecosystem to ensure a high survival rate and contribute to the region's biodiversity.
- Transportation is not included and must be organized by the company.
- If weather conditions are unfavorable, we will reschedule the reforestation day to ensure the safety and comfort of all participants.
- Menus and snacks can be adapted to special dietary needs, allergies, or intolerances if notified in advance.
- We recommend bringing comfortable clothing, sturdy shoes, water, a raincoat, and a hat or cap for sun protection. We provide gloves and planting tools.
- Our team will offer all necessary training to ensure everyone can participate, regardless of prior experience.
- These sessions are family-friendly. We encourage employees to bring their children and other family members to enjoy the day together.
